



She has performed for women fighting cancer, children with disabilities, and is highly sought-after speaker, and community advocate for inspiring women who have been abused. An evening out listening to the sounds of award-winning vocalist Karen Brown is like spending the night with the biggest musical legends of our time. Karen blends the soulful artistry of her church choir experience with the moving emotions of the great music legends and delivers a performance that is uniquely her own. She sings in the KEY of LOVE while specializing in the genres of R&B, Gospel, Soul and more. With a voice that captures the epitome of versatility, there's

no limit to what Brown can do. Karen doesn't strive to receive personal praise and glory for her accomplishments, as she attributes all of her success to her Creator.

Karen Camper

Rep. Karen Camper, a Memphis native, has been a dedicated representative for the 87th House District since 2008. in 2018 she made history as the first African American woman to lead a Caucus in Tennessee's General Assembly, she serves on various committees, including the House Finance. Transportation and Commerce. In addition, she is a retired CW3 with 21 years of service in the Army, she is also a proud member of the VFW Post #11333. She is a former substitute teacher and business owner. Rep. Camper is a well-rounded individual, having attended the UT Knoxville and holds an A.S. degree, State University of New York. She is active in various community roles, she's the former President of the National Organization of Black Elected Legislative Women. She's a founder and attends New Beginning All Life Ministry church, where she serves as Treasurer, on the Usher Board, and Building Fund. In her personal life, she is a proud mother to her adult son, Bruce Jr. and grandson Zyion Jones.



Judge Carol J. Chumney



Carol J. Chumney is an elected Shelby County Circuit Court Judge. Her passion for public service led her to run for and win election to the Tennessee State House at the age of 29. She served thirteen years, was House Majority Whip, and earned numerous awards. Chumney also served four years as an elected Memphis city council member. In 2007, Chumney's second-place finish in the Memphis mayoral election is the closest a woman has ever come in the city's history. As an attorney, she took the fight for election voting security to the U.S. Supreme Court and Congress. Her book, The Arena: One Woman's Story, has earned national awards. The book sheds light on the need for integrity in politics and the barriers that prevent women from achieving higher office. It also sets out Chumney's core

values taught by her parents: Courage, Character, Compassion & most important - Jesus Christ.

Rev. Tracey Coleman

Reverend Tracey Coleman is a native of Memphis TN; mother of one son. She faithfully serves as an Associate Minister at Berean M.B. Church. She has 25 years of managerial experience and currently works as a Sales Support Analyst at T.D. SYNNEX. Board, Church Trustee, Member of the Christian Education, Youth Worker, and Sunday School Superintendent.


Dr. Pamela Davis


Rico D. Kones
